

MARRIAGE OR CIVIL UNION

Persons wishing to be married may file an application with the Weymouth Township Registrar. Applicants, one of whom lives in Weymouth Township, may apply for the marriage license here and be married in any municipality in the State of New Jersey. If neither applicant resides in Weymouth Township, they may still make an application here, but must then hold their marriage ceremony within Weymouth Township.

Marriage applications require a 72 hour waiting period between the time the application is first made to the time the License can be issued by the Registrar. Once the License is issued, it is valid for thirty (30) days within which time the ceremony must take place. There is a \$28 fee for this License which must be paid for by check or cash, we do not take credit cards.

Once you are married, the official performing the ceremony will file the completed license with the Registrar of the Municipality where the marriage actually took place and that Registrar will file it with the State Registrar. Marriage Certificates with raised seals can be obtained from the Registrar as described above.
