This Regular Meeting of the Weymouth Township Committee was called to order by Chairman Kenneth R. Haeser who led the assembly in the Salute to our Nation's Flag and a moment of silence. The Acting Township Clerk then read aloud the "Sunshine Law Statement" and called the roll.

Roll Call: Doyle-Present, Keiffenheim-Present, Haeser-Present.  
Also present at this meeting were Michael Peacock, Township Solicitor, Michael Fralinger, Township Engineer, Ronald Carroll, Director of Public Works, and Dorothy-Jo Ayres, Acting Township Clerk.

#### MAYOR'S REPORT:

Mayor Haeser reported that earlier in the afternoon today he spoke to the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade class at Weymouth Township School about Municipal Government. Bonnie and Douglas Yearsley spoke to the 4<sup>th</sup> grade about our Township's history.

The Mayor participated in a telephone conference with Verizon. The Verizon strike has been resolved and the employees are returning to work. Mayor Haeser explained that it is hard to boost our economic growth with such poor telephone service. He and Mayor Teasenfitz of Estell Manor will be going on a ride along with Verizon executives this month.

On May 23<sup>rd</sup> Mayor Haeser met with Mayor Chuck Chiarello to discuss the joining of Hamilton Township and Buena Vista Township Court system. The township will be researching our options prior to the January 1, 2017 change over.

Bonnie Yearsley will be doing a presentation on the Municipal Service Fee for the Acorn Association on Monday June 6<sup>th</sup>.

The Dorothy Volunteer Fire Company is holding their annual Chicken BBQ on Sunday June 5<sup>th</sup>.

#### PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR:

Mr. Craig of Riverside Drive requested speed limit signs be placed on Lowell Avenue. He stressed the danger of constant speeding especially in the morning and afternoon school bus pick up and drop off times.

Mrs. Messina, also of Riverside Drive, added that she has witnessed many vehicles going through the stop at the corner of Lowell and Loretta.

After further discussion between the Township Engineer and Township Committee the Acting Township Clerk was directed to contact the State Police to notify of ongoing traffic problem in that area, and motion was made to place a speed limit sign on Lowell.

Mr. Carroll, Public Works Director, said the work could be done in house as long as the test is negative for asbestos.
