WHEREAS, There exists a need for the services of a Township Animal Control Officer for 2015, and

WHEREAS, Funds are available for this purpose, and

WHEREAS, Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et. seq.) requires that the resolution authorizing the award of contracts for "Professional Services", without competitive bids must be publicly advertised:

WHEREAS, In regard to current "Pay to Play" legislation, it is anticipated that the total payment for the services of the Animal Control Officer will not exceed the amount of \$17,500.00 for the year 2015,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Weymouth, County of Atlantic, as follows:

This contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a "Professional Service" under the provision of the Local Public Contracts Law, because the law permits the waiving of competitive bids under N.J.S.A. 40A:5-11.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, George Garbaravage of Animal Capture and Control, 270 Frog Pond Road, Parkertown, NJ 08087, is hereby appointed Animal Control Officer for the Township of Weymouth for the fiscal year of 2015.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this contract has been awarded to George Garbaravage based on the merits and abilities of George Garbaravage to provide the goods or services as described herein. This contract was awarded through a "Non-Fair and Open Process" pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.. As such, the undersigned does hereby attest that George Garbaravage, and Animal Capture and Control, 270 Frog Pond Road, Parkertown, NJ 08087, its subsidiaries, assigns or principals controlling in excess of 10% of the company has neither made a contribution, that is reportable pursuant to the Election Law Enforcement Commission pursuant to N.J.S.A.19:44A-8 or pursuant to P.L. 2004,c19, affect its eligibility to perform this contract, nor will it make a reportable contribution during the term of the contract to any political party committee in the Township of Weymouth if a member of that political party is serving in an elective public office of that municipality when the contract is awarded, or to any candidate committee of any person serving in an elective public office of the municipality when the contract is awarded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be published at least once in the Atlantic County Record, pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 198 or the laws of 1971.
