

WACYL Leadership Succession Planning Underway

For those newest members of the community it is important you get involved in the organization. If the parents of the youngest participants in our programs do not get involved the programs offered by WACYL will slowly disappear.


The current leadership has announced their departure from the league over the next several months. The time to transition is now as the entire leadership team will be departed by July 2016.

The Weymouth Township Environmental Commission will host a free seedling give away on Saturday, April 9th from 9 AM to Noon at the Weymouth Township Municipal Building located at 45 South Jersey Avenue in Dorothy.
